

After Advocating for Funding, Slaughter Pleased to Announced Funding for 2-Way Conversion of St. Paul Street and North Clinton Ave

WASHINGTON – Congresswoman Louise Slaughter (NY-28) today announced that she has secured competitive federal funding of a \$562,500 project to convert St. Paul Street and North Clinton Avenue into 2-way streets. When this project is complete, 2-way traffic will flow on these streets between Main Street and the Inner Loop. The funding is being provided by the U.S. Department of Transportation. Earlier this year, Slaughter wrote to the Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Ray LaHood, to advocate for full funding of this project.

"Today, Rochester takes one more step in developing a sustainable and multi-modal transportation network. Full funding of this project is good news for downtown residents, business owners, bike riders, and the disability community- all of whom rely on these streets to move safely and efficiently. From roads to rails, I remain dedicated to providing Rochesterians with an efficient and modern transportation network for the 21st century."
