Rochester, NY - Congresswoman Louise M. Slaughter (D-NY-28), Chairwoman of the House Committee on Rules, today issued this statement following recent reports that Eastman Kodak Co. will cut around 1,300 jobs locally:

"It is a tragedy for me to watch Eastman Kodak go from employing around 60,000 people when I was first elected to a fraction of that number today.
