Rep. Slaughter Applauds Passage of Stimulus Package

Bill Now Headed to President's Desk for Signature

Washington, DC – Rep. Louise M. Slaughter (D-NY-28), Chairwoman of the House Rules Committee, today issued the following statement on the passage of the economic stimulus bill through the House and Senate.
