

Passport Day 2012

Tomorrow from 10am to 3pm, Western New York's only passport agency, located at 111 Genesee Street in Buffalo, will join the U.S. Department of State to celebrate Passport Day in the USA 2012.

Among the services offered tomorrow:

- U.S. Citizens will be able to apply for and renew a U.S. passport without the usually necessary appointment.
- U.S. Citizens will be able to apply for an expedited passport, meaning it would be processed within 2-3 weeks instead of the usual 4-6 weeks
- Local experts from the Buffalo Passport Agency will be on hand to answer questions on cross-border and international travel.

U.S. citizens must present a valid passport book when entering or re-entering the United States by air. U.S. citizens entering the United States from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean, and Bermuda at land borders and sea ports of entry must present a passport book, passport card, or other travel documents approved by the U. S. government.
