Artwork categories are as follows:

&bull; Paintings: oil, acrylics, watercolor,  
etc.

&bull; Drawings: pastels, colored pencil,  
pencil, charcoal, ink, markers

&bull; Collage: must be two dimensional

&bull; Prints: lithographs, silkscreen,  
block prints

&bull; Mixed Media: use of more than two  
mediums such as pencil, ink, etc.

&bull; Computer generated art
