Event Also Showcases Department's New Mobile Command Unit

Washington, DC - Rep. Louise M. Slaughter (D-Fairport), Ranking Member of the House Rules Committee, was honored today in a ceremony recognizing her commitment to Niagara's police force. The Congresswoman secured \$76,000 in funding for the Department's new Mobile Command Unit, which was also highlighted at the event. The Command Unit will reduce police response times and improve the safety of Niagara residents.

At the event, Rep. Slaughter was made an honorary member of the Town of Niagara's Police Department.

"I am deeply touched by this ceremony, and I was so pleased to have been able to get these officers the funding they needed," Rep. Slaughter said. "The real credit should go to them.
